### **Parsons Brinckerhoff part of Logan Water Alliance**

Parsons Brinckerhoff (PB) is part of the successful team to deliver one of Australia's largest water infrastructure delivery programs – the \$300 million Logan Water Alliance.

With PB's alliance partners Logan Water, Tenix Alliance and Cardno, the Logan Water Alliance will deliver a three to five-year program of works in Logan City.

The program includes the planning, design, construction and commissioning of critical water, wastewater and recycled water infrastructure.

Uniquely, this Alliance will involve the incorporation of more than 20 current Logan Water staff into the Alliance team.

Alliance mobilisation activities are already well underway with critical prioritisation of extensive infrastructure planning programs and capital works delivery programs.

The Alliance will provide Logan City Council and its water business, Logan Water, with the capacity to deliver new and improved water, wastewater and recycled water infrastructure across key growth areas.

PB Alliance Leadership Group member Brian Horton noted this project was a good indication that PB's team is recognised for its water expertise.

"This project is an important opportunity for PB to be part of the continuing development of water and wastewater infrastructure services in Queensland," said Mr Horton.

PB is currently involved in some of Australia's most significant water program projects including the Mackay Infrastructure Alliance, Sydney Water's Sewerfix Wet Weather Alliance and Sydney Networks Alliance.

PB recently completed Bundamba Advanced Water Treatment Plant, built for the Queensland Government, and delivered on budget and faster than the industry standard. This project was also named Water Project of the Year by Global Water Intelligence.

Logan City is located between Brisbane and the Gold Coast in south east Queensland, and is a major growth corridor. The City expanded to 261,000 residents in 2008 following recent local government amalgamations, and is expected to attract an additional 120,000 residents by 2026.
